What Not to Bring:

Asbestos	Motor Oil	Antifreeze

Shock Sensitive Materials	Unknown or Unlabeled Materials	

Tires -limit 2 per person at transfer station

Latex Paint - Remove lid, dry completely and dispose of as trash at the Transfer Station once it is dry.
