

SOUTHBOROUGH HERITAGE DAY CELEBRATION 2013

Parade Participants,

We look forward to the upcoming Heritage Day Parade on Monday, October 14, 2013. The parade route begins at St. Anne's Church and ends near the entrance to St. Mark's School on Rt. 85 and the entrance to St. Mark's Street also off of Rt. 85. **The parade does NOT end at the corner of Rt. 30 and Rt. 85. Please continue to walk north on Rt. 85 so that there is no congestion at the corner. All parents should pick up children at the end of the parade route.** Please see attached map.

Set up time is 9:30am and step off is 10:00am

This year's parade will be very similar to years past with one exception. **For safety reason, there will be no cars allowed to pass through or park behind St. Anne's church. Please car pool whenever possible.**

- **DROP OFF LOCATION:** Designated behind the Church on the corner of Upland and Walker Rd. If you have young participants in your group please make the parents aware so they can make arrangements for a safe drop off.
- **PICK UP LOCATION:** The parade will disperse on Route 85 North & Entrance to St. Marks Street. Please meet your child at that location to pick them up. Do not plan to meet your child at the corner of Rt. 30 and Rt. 85.
