

**BETH ISRAEL DEACONESS MEDICAL CENTER NAMES

BOSTON – Southborough resident Colin Owyang was appointed to the Board of Overseers of Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center at BIDMC’s Annual Meeting.

Owyang serves on the Board of Trustees of Framingham State University, the Board of Visitors for the Fay School, and the Board of Directors of the Boston Lawyers’ Group. Owyang is also on the legal committees of the Edison Electric Institute and the American Gas Association.

Owyang is a graduate of Yale College, Yale University, and the University of Michigan Law School.
