**8<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List**  
**2015-2016**

To the parents and guardians of incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders:

After careful review, we have decided upon the following supply list for eighth graders. It has been suggested that students follow a proposed organizational system referred to by SOAR Study Skills. Please see the link on the Trottier Home Page. Of course, students can and should follow a method they find most helpful. For example, if they chose to have a separate binder for each subject, that is fine.

**SOAR system:**

- \* One, 2" diameter binder with pockets on the inside covers
- \* One plastic folder (color-coded: red, blue, purple, yellow, green and other for foreign language) for each individual class, such as Avery Binder Pockets
- \* One file folder for each class (to keep at home for storing material not in immediate use)- color coded works well
- \* Labels (or permanent marker) for each folder and binder pocket

Additionally, the following courses require:

**English**

- 8" X 10" composition notebook (approx. 100 pages)
- 1 pack of note cards 3 x 5 inches

**Reading**

- 1 inch 3-ring binder

**Science**

- 8" X 10" composition notebook (approx. 100 pages)

**Math**

- Pack of graph paper
- Two white board markers

**Social Studies**

- One pack of 3 x 5 note cards
- 1 ½ inch 3-ring binder
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**A Year's Supply**

- 3-hole punched white lined paper (3 packages)
- reinforcements
- erasable pens (at least 24)
- pencils (at least 48)
- red correcting pens
- 10 loose-leaf index dividers for 3-ring binders
- highlighters
- case to hold pens, pencils, etc. (optional, but suggested)
- a set of colored pencils
- box of Kleenex (please bring to homeroom )

Also, you will need an assignment book. You can buy a Trottier Middle School assignment book for \$5.00 either the week before school starts or on the first day of school. Otherwise, please bring your own planner on the first day.
