Greetings Mark;

On June 23, 2015 I did an inspection at the above property with and at the request of DPW Superintendent Karen Galligan to determine if the property was structurally stable. I have included pictures taken that day for your review, my findings are as follows:


The exterior walls are bowing significantly, the rear portion of the structure is under partial collapse; the main structure has a stone foundation under partial collapse both on the gable (nonstructural) wall and on the front structural wall, this has compromised the floor framing and the building should not be entered, additionally, it should be razed at the Towns earliest opportunity as it has become a life safety issue.

I have also reached out to Chairman Hubley of the Historic Commission and on August 31, 2015 I received notification that the structure does not meet the criteria of the Demolition delay bylaw and a permit could be issued forthwith.



REAR STRUCTURE UNDER PARTIAL COLLAPSE







FIELD STONE FOUNDATION

STRUCTURE









WINDOW FALLING OUT DUE TO BOWED GABLE WALL
