



Letter to the Editor: Bill Boland - Write-in Candidate for re-election to the Board of Commissioners of Trust Funds.

I am honored to have served the residents of Southborough for several terms as one of three members of the Board of Commissioners of Trust Funds. I know, that's a long name for the Board. Basically we administer a series of Trust Funds bequest by former residents. The purpose of the funds is to assist current residents who may have unexpected financial needs that they need assistance with. We work closely with The Senior Center, Youth and Family Services, the Southborough Food Pantry and Local Parishes to identify residents with needs. Identities of those who receive assistance are kept strictly confidential.

Examples of our funding might be, helping to pay for an oil delivery in the winter, assisting with electric bills to keep service from being disconnected, helping to replace a water heater for someone without the funds to do it.
