



What is a possible in-school transmission? A possible in-school transmission is when an individual is identified as a close contact in school and subsequently tests positive. It is labeled as potential transmission because sometimes, in addition to the exposure at school, these individuals may also have had additional recent exposures outside of school.

What is probable in-school transmission? A probable in-school transmission is when an individual is identified as a close contact in school and subsequently tests positive and they had no other known exposure outside of school.

What happens when there is an in-school transmission? The Medical Advisory Team meets to review the data associated with the case, evaluates the mitigation strategies that are being employed and advises on next steps. Some of the things we evaluate are: the activities happening, air quality, distancing and masking in the areas where transmission may have happened.

The population data the state uses for their calculations are not from the most recent census. Additionally, not all of the individuals in each age category identified by the state attend the Public Schools of Northborough and Southborough.
