Join us for the Southborough Health Department's annual FLU CLINIC hosted in the Senior Center! CDC and ACIP preferentially recommend the use of higher-dose flu vaccines over standard-dose flu vaccines for people 65 years and older. This recommendation is based on a review of available studies which suggests that, in this age group, these vaccines are potentially more effective than standard dose flu vaccines. As we age our immune system weakens, and the high dose flu vaccine increases our immune response when 65+ individuals come in contact with the influenza virus. The flu virus can lead to significant complications such as pneumonia, but complications increase even more for seniors and children. If you have any questions or concerns regarding influenza or the flu vaccine you can contact the Health Department at 508-281-8983 or Nurse Leslie during her office hours on Tuesday and Friday.
